Cornerstone is hosting a Blood Drive on Tuesday, August 11, from 2pm until 8pm. Sign up begins today in the Gathering Space.

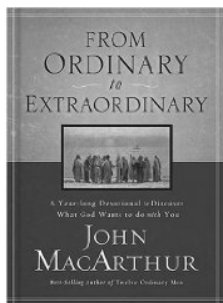
